Dear Mr. Gleason:

In receipt of your letter of 8 October, 2004, dismissing my complaints against Mr. Miller.

In my naiveté, I had not realized the legal position of the Attorney Regulation Counsel as regards the complained attorney. I thought I asked for an investigation, as contrasts a judgment, and I regret my misunderstanding.

If there is some insufficiency of evidence or proofs in your hand, I'll rectify that in the Appeal Process to the Supreme Court as recommended by Judge Lucero's office.

I've never been interviewed by your Investigator; neither any Witness I cited in my information given your Office. No one from your Office has ever asked for any further information, or expository material, or the broad quantity of other evidence that proves a pattern of Mr. Miller's similar behaviour with other clients and associates and in other professional situations.

There has been no investigation, and I'm not sure on what possible information an informed dismissal could have been rendered. There is simply too broad a scope and too many different complaints against **Thomas C. 'Doc' Miller** to dismiss out of hand.

I have asked for your office's guidance throughout this process. While I did not expect unqualified advocacy, I did anticipate some modicum of responsible direction to a layman complaining the professional misconduct and services of one of your associates, and making a proffer of proof.

I don't know anything about your grievance procedure except what I've read, which seemed to indicate that your office would be somewhat more forthcoming as to what evidence you require; affidavits made, documents/communications, eye-witnesses, records or what have you.

These are not frivolous reports against Mr. Miller and I stand prepared to prove it.

My complaints against Attorney Miller have a solid basis in both fact and law, as well as in your Professional Code as regards standards for conduct and performance.
