

On 10/19/00, at approx. 1100 hours, I was notified by the Capitol Command Center that Mr. Steve Gartin was en route to the Governor's Office. I entered the reception area and sat by the receptionist's desk.

At approx. 1105 hours, two men entered the Governor's reception area. One man I recognized as Mr. Steve Gartin. Mr. Gartin then asked if the Governor was in his office. He was advised by the receptionist, Marie Garcia, that the Governor's location was not known.

Mr. Gartin then asked the receptionist if he could leave some paperwork for the Governor. The receptionist agreed to take the papers (Petition for Redress of Grievance) from Mr. Gartin. Mr. Gartin and the other man then left the Governor's reception area. I then took the papers from the receptionist's desk.

At approx. 1645 hours, Mr. Gartin returned to the Governor's reception area and dropped off another paper (Letter Rogatory) for the Governor. The receptionist then put the paper on my desk so that I may discover it the next day.

I then took all of these papers and gave them to Investigator Gary Clyman on 10/20/99.
